Thursday- Apples with Sugar Free Caramel or Sugar Free Chocolate for Dipping

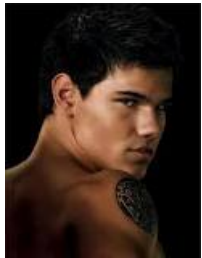
