The Need To Know

<u>Re-registration for 2014-2015 After School Program</u>

Current ASP Participants can re-register the following days: Tuesday, June 17th– 9am to 5:30pm

Wednesday & Thursday, June 18th & 19th- 8am-6pm

The total cost for the 2014-2015 School Year is \$115.

(Sibling payment plans are as follows: 1st- \$115, 2nd-\$90, 3rd-\$65 and 4th-\$40) <u>A \$25 deposit is due, for each child, at the time of re-registration. The balance</u> is due no later than Friday, August 22nd.

If you do not register your child by June 19th, your child will no longer be in the program. If you register your child after the 23rd, they will be place on the waiting list. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

New Registration (including siblings) begins on Monday, June 23rd at 9am. Parents with children on the waiting list do not need to re-register, MYSB staff will contact you when there is a spot open for the ASP.
