The Need to Know

Re-registration for 2015-2016 After School Program

Current ASP Participants re-registration:

Monday, June 1st- Friday, June 5th 8am-6pm

The total cost for the 2015-2016 School Year is \$115.

(Sibling payment plans are as follows: 1st- \$115, 2nd-\$90, 3rd-\$65 and 4th-\$40) <u>A \$25 deposit is due, for each child, at the time of re-registration.</u> <u>The balance is due no later than Friday, August 21st.</u>

If you do not register your child by 6pm on June 5th, your child will no longer be in the program. (No re-registration will be accepted between June 5th and June 21st). If you register your child after the 22nd, they will be place on the waiting list.

NO EXCEPTIONS!

New Registration (including siblings) begins on Monday, June 22nd at 9am.

Mandatory Parent Meeting for <u>ALL Parents</u> will be held in August.
